WELDING FABRICATION (Virtual)

Contest Description

The purpose of this contest is to evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in the field of welding fabrication. The contest is open to a team of three active SkillsUSA members enrolled in programs with welding as the occupational objective. Teams will be required to submit a resume and complete an online contest/exam in lieu of an in-person competition.

Regional Competition

Students will complete the exam electronically on **January 23, 2021**. Students should be ready to take the exam at their scheduled time. The schedule and times will be emailed to the advisor/contestants by Friday, December 11, 2020. Changes cannot be made to scheduled time slots. Resumes must be submitted electronically to SkillsUSA California (details to follow).

Students will complete the contest/exam individually. An average score will be calculated based on all three team members' exam scores.

Knowledge Performance

The contest will include a 50 to 100 question online knowledge exam that assesses the practical knowledge of welding, including safety, measurement and blueprint reading. Other common fabrication operations will also be assessed such as saw operation, drilling, grinding and material handling, as well as general SkillsUSA framework knowledge.
