Eligibility

Open to all active SkillsUSA members.

Clothing Requirements

Mechanics: Proper grammar is used and diction is clear

Closing: Closing provides a clear and solid conclusion and summary of the speech **Effectiveness:** Assigned topic is covered and the purpose of the speech is clear and achieved

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
