CREED (Virtual)

Contest Description

This contest follows all State Standards & Guidelines.

Contestants are to recite, from memory, the SkillsUSA Creed and answer questions about the meaning of each of the parts of the Creed. This is a regional and state only contest and does not advance to nationals.

Regional Competition

ONLY middle school and high school freshmen are eligible to compete in this contest.

The total time allowed for questions and answers is two minutes. The contestant will be stopped if the time limit is exceeded.

Students will compete in this competition live over the Zoom platform on January 9, 2021. Students should be ready to present at their scheduled time. The contestant schedule will be emailed to the advisor/contestants by Friday, December 11, 2020. Changes cannot be made to scheduled time slots. **Resumes must be submitted** to SkillsUSA California **by January 2, 2021** (details to follow).

Contest Guidelines

Recitation

- Contestants should prepare for the SkillsUSA Creed recitation by developing the following competencies:
 1. Demonstrate an effective delivery style
 2. Pronounce words in a clear and understandable manner
 3. Demonstrate good platform deportment and personal confidence
 4. Effectively vary voice in pitch, tone, tempo, and volume

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5. Contestants will answer a follow up question after their presentation

- The topic for the recitation is the official SkillsUSA Creed (Long Version) as published in the most current SkillsUSA Leadership Handbook
- The contestant may not use a manuscript, note cards or any other written materials
- No introductory or concluding remarks to the SkillsUSA Creed will be allowed other than the title and author.
- One judge will serve as a prompter to assist students who falter (10 seconds) during a recitation
- Contestants will not mention their name, school, city or state

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SkillsUSA CREED INTERVIEW QUESTIONS

The following questions may be used during the interview with students. One question per judge. Not to exceed 3 minutes for questions and answers. The same question must be asked to all contestants.

1. Describe a time when you were faced with a stressful situation that demonstrated your coping skills.
2. Give a specific example of a time when you used good judgment and logic in solving a problem.
3. Give an example of a time when you set a goal and were able to meet or achieve it.
4. Tell me about a time when you had to go above and beyond the call of duty in order to get a job done.
5. Give an example of how you set goals and achieve them
6. What personal characteristics do you feel are necessary for success?

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
