# JOB SKILLS DEMO A & DEMO O (Virtual)

## **Contest Description**

This contest follows all National Standards & Guidelines.

Contestants are to give a 3-5 minute oral presentation that demonstrates an entry-level skill used in the occupational area in which they are enrolled. Contestants are to explain and demonstrate a career objective in an occupational area that is currently one of the contest areas of SkillsUSA.

Please see the official SkillsUSA Job Skills Demonstration A Technical Standards for approved visual aids and other contest restrictions and requirements.

**Students will compete in this competition live over the Zoom platform on January 9, 2021 (Open) and January 16, 2021 (A).** Students should be ready to present at their scheduled time. The schedule will be emailed to the advisor/contestants by Friday, December 11, 2020. Changes cannot be made to scheduled time slots. Resumes must be submitted to SkillsUSA California by January 2, 2021 (details to follow).

### **Knowledge Performance**

There is no written exam for this contest.

#### Skill Performance

The contest requires the virtual demonstration of a performance of an occupational skill within the chosen career pathway accompanied by a clear explanation of the topic through the use of experiments, displays or practical operations.
