JOB SKILLS DEMO A & DEMO O (Virtual)

Contest Description

This contest follows all National Standards & Guidelines.

Contestants are to give a 3-5 minute oral presentation that demonstrates an entry-level skill used in the occupational area in which they are enrolled. Contestants are to explain and demonstrate a career objective in an occupational area that is currently one of the contest areas of SkillsUSA.

Please see the official SkillsUSA Job Skills Demonstration A Technical Standards for approved visual aids and other contest restrictions and requirements.

Students will compete in this competition live over the Zoom platform on January 9, 2021 (Open) and January 16, 2021 (A). Students should be ready to present at their scheduled time. The schedule will be emailed to the advisor/contestants by Friday, December 11, 2020. Changes cannot be made to scheduled time slots. **Resumes** must be submitted to SkillsUSA California **by January 2, 2021** (details to follow).

Knowledge Performance

There is no written exam for this contest.

Skill Performance

The contest requires the virtual demonstration of a performance of an occupational skill within the chosen career pathway accompanied by a clear explanation of the topic through the use of experiments, displays or practical operations.

Contestant Materials List:

1. PDF of Resume (SkillsUSA format)

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2. Items for demonstration (charts, laptop, visuals, equipment...)
3. Computer with high-speed internet capability and camera to use applications such as Zoom. The minimum recommended internet bandwidth speeds for joining Zoom meetings, accessing on-demand curriculum and other online operations is 2.0 Mbps up and down.
